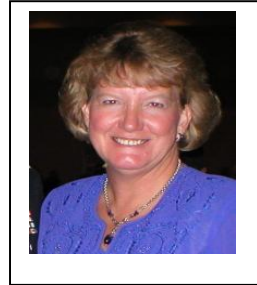

EANGUS AUXILIARY MEMBERSHIP CHALLENGE

Strength in membership grows our voice on Capitol Hill as we continue the mission to support EANGUS through our grassroots efforts.

EANGUS Membership Chair, Don Wood has crunched the numbers that show EANGUS currently has 41,500 dues-paying members.

Through dedicated and aggressive recruiting teamwork – *the commitment of state auxiliary members and support of state enlisted members – side by side – to promote visibility and create more auxiliary awareness*, EANGUS Auxiliary can equate dues-paying members to or at least close to the number of EANGUS members.

The following are informational points of guide to use or incorporate in your existing guide for the promotion of visibility and creation of more auxiliary awareness of our elite grassroots organization, The Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States Auxiliary (EANGUS Auxiliary).

1. Membership classifications and qualifications
 - a. Annual member: An individual must be the spouse of a member in good standing, or of a deceased member in good standing at the time of his/her death, of the ENLISTED ASSOCIATION OF THE NATIONAL GUARD OF THE UNITED STATES. The individual also must be a member of a state auxiliary – *refer to your resident state dues structure available on the EANGUS website at www.eangus.org under About Auxiliary.*
 - b. Life member: An annual member may become a life member by payment of an amount approved by the membership, in addition to the annual dues which apply until the applicant reaches the age of sixty (60). This is a nonrefundable payment – *refer to your respective state auxiliary for life membership application form and payment calculator. Verification of eligibility must be provided for life membership application processing along with dues payment.*
 - c. Associate member: Individuals who support the objectives of the AUXILIARY, but are not otherwise qualified for annual or lifetime membership in the ENLISTED ASSOCIATION OF THE NATIONAL GUARD OF THE UNITED STATES AUXILIARY. A national associate member must be an associate member of a state that is chartered. An associate member shall not be a voting delegate, eligible for scholarships, or qualified to hold office in the AUXILIARY – *refer to your resident state dues structure available on the EANGUS website at www.eangus.org under About Auxiliary.*
2. Membership dues help pay for operational expenses at state and national levels to keep the auxiliaries viable and strong.
3. Members receive a state and or national membership card and a confirmation letter from the EANGUS Auxiliary President – *national membership cards are mailed to each state auxiliary upon request from state president/treasurer or point of contact to EANGUS Auxiliary Membership Chair.*
4. Members receive electronic issues of the Auxiliary's newsletter publication –The Signal published monthly (*with the exception of the month of August*) by the Auxiliary President. *Members can receive a hard copy by submitting the current prescribed annual donation.* The Signal includes valuable information such as:
 - a. current information and updates on everything from Area Caucus/Mid-Winter conferences to state and national annual conferences as well as other organizational events
 - b. what the National Guard is achieving
 - c. Recent legislative victories and challenges
5. Members have a voice on Capitol Hill when they take action in response to EANGUS Legislative Action Alerts via letters, emails, telephone calls or personal visits to the congressional leadership on issues and benefits that affect the National Guard and their families.
6. EANGUS Auxiliary annual and life members, spouses and their dependent children are eligible to apply for a one-time educational scholarship valued from \$500 to \$1,000.
7. Members share a wonderful experience of knowledge, history and camaraderie.

8. EANGUS Auxiliary has a Member Recruiting Recognition Awards Program and Contest Drawing that afford members:
 - a. State recognition – for annual, life and associate according to membership category – *for the largest member increase and largest percentage increase in membership*
 - b. Individual recognition for Recruiting Member of the Year – *the individual who recruits the second largest number of members and every other individual who recruits at least five new members from 01 August of the current year and the information is received by the EANGUS Auxiliary Membership Chair by but not later than 01 June of the current year*
 - c. A drawing contest where the recruiting member's name is entered into the drawing one time for each member the individual has recruited
9. Ask your state enlisted association to include the auxiliary in any/all recruiting plans/opportunities.

We will have a membership booth at the 2011 National Conference in Charleston, West Virginia. Please consider donating a little of your time to help staff the booth. Information and membership forms will be provided.

Begin today – encourage your current members to commit to sign up members – *individuals who have never joined before as well as individuals who were former members*. Ensure that your state president, treasurer or point of contact get the completed applications and dues payments so that the member/s information and dues payments are submitted to the EANGUS Auxiliary Treasurer timely – *annual and associate dues payments sent to the EANGUS Auxiliary Treasurer after 25 February through 31 December 2011, will be 2012 paid memberships*.

Accept the challenge –commit to help your state sign-up 100 MEMBERS!

Reference: Scholarship Rules

The Scholarship Committee of EANGUS Auxiliary is accepting applications for the school year 2011-2012. If funds are available, one scholarship in the amount of \$1250.00 will be awarded to the number one ranked applicant and three scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each will be awarded, one being the scholarship donated by USAA.

1. Please read materials carefully before giving any applications to candidates. Be prepared to give assistance if needed. No previous recipients are allowed to apply again.

2. In order for each application to be considered, it MUST contain the following documentation – NO EXCEPTIONS.

a. High School/College Transcripts.

b. Three signed Letters of Recommendation

c. Letter from Applicant containing future goals and need for assistance.

d. A Letter of Recommendation and Transmittal from the State Auxiliary President, Scholarship Chairperson or Designee.

3. EANGUS Auxiliary sponsor must have dues paid to National Auxiliary no later than December 31, 2010.

4. For applicants to be eligible, sponsor's State Auxiliary must make a donation to the EANGUS Auxiliary Scholarship Fund for the current and prior year. (Suggested donation is \$2.00 per member annually payable by December 31.)

It will be the responsibility of each State to make the information available to their membership. You may copy the application, however, DO NOT reduce it. Each State is to designate a Scholarship Chairperson and the applications returned to that person by a specific date. The application should then be reviewed to ensure all requirements have been met. Any incorrect applications received by the National Committee will be considered ineligible.

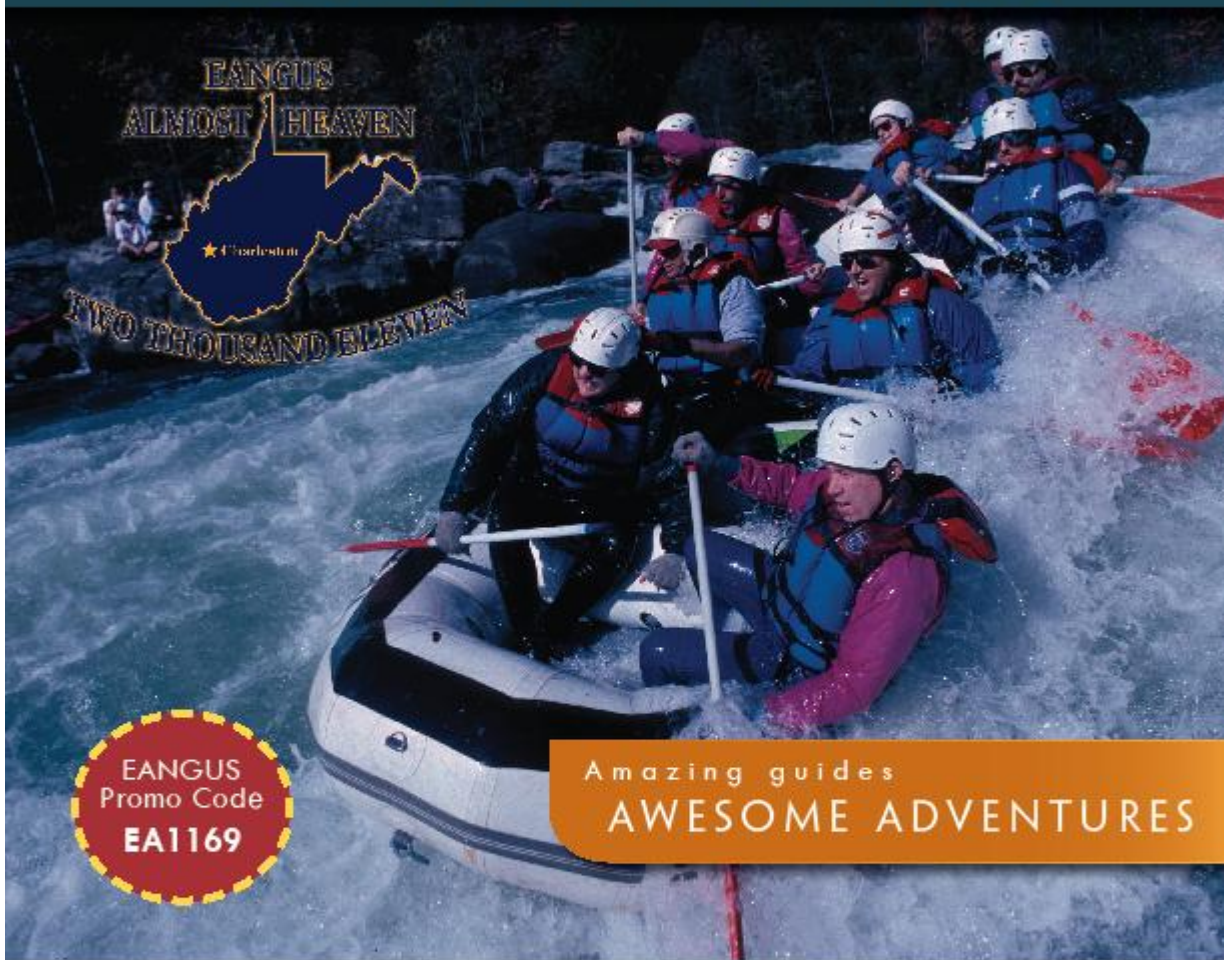

1. Purpose: To provide significant recognition to any individual who shall distinguish himself/herself with outstanding service at a state and/or national level.
2. Eligibility: Any member of the EANGUS Auxiliary not currently serving on the Executive Board.
3. Criteria: The following criteria is established to serve as guidelines in the selection of recipients for this award.
 - A. An individual must have distinguished himself/herself with exceptionally outstanding service at a state and/or national level.
4. Nomination Requirement:
 - A. Letter(s) of recommendations by state auxiliary member.
 - B. Endorsement of state auxiliary president.
 - C. Nomination packet deadline is July 15 of current year.
 - D. Mail packet directly to Secretary/Awards Chair.
 - E. Recommendations by Awards Chair presented at the first Executive Board meeting during the annual conference.

EANGUS AUXILIARY OUTSTANDING DIRECTORS' AWARD

1. Eligible Persons: Area Directors
2. Criteria: Contribution, achievements, service to the EANGUS Auxiliary and the respective auxiliaries within the states they represent.
3. Selection Method:

POINT SYSTEM:

- 50 Points: Charter/bringing back a dormant state.
- 20 Points: Area Director newsletters sent to Secretary/Awards Chair.
- 25 Points: Area Directors newsletters sent to National President.
- 30 Points: Quarterly Reports submitted to the National President.
- 25 Points: For each state conference attended (documentation required to include copy of registration and/or receipt of hotel accommodations).
- 25 Points: For attendance to EANGUS/EANGUS Auxiliary Area Caucuses/Mid-Winter Conferences (documentation required to include copy of registration and/or receipt of hotel accommodations)

EANGUS AUXILIARY MERITORIOUS SERVICE AWARD

1. Purpose: To recognize an individual's outstanding contributions, achievements, and service to the EANGUS Auxiliary.
2. Eligibility: Any member of the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS).
3. Criteria: The following criteria is established to serve as guidelines in the selection of recipients for this award.
 - A. Outstanding performance by the individual must have been such as to clearly identify the nominee as having played a key role in the accomplishments for which this award is to be given.
 - B. Although a single accomplishment may be considered for this award, priority consideration should be given to those individuals who have contributed outstanding service on a sustained basis.
 - C. Personal dedication and self-sacrifice also will be regarded as factors deserving consideration.
4. Nomination Requirement
 - A. Letter(s) of recommendation by State Auxiliary member(s).
 - B. Endorsement by State Auxiliary President.
 - C. AND/OR letter(s) of recommendation by National Auxiliary officer and/or Area Directors.
 - D. Endorsement by National Auxiliary President.
 - E. Nomination packet deadline is July 15 of current year.
 - F. Mail packet directly to Secretary/Awards Chair.
 - G. Recommendations by Awards Chair presented at the first Executive Board meeting during the annual conference.

EANGUS AUXILIARY SPOUSE OF THE YEAR AWARD

1. Purpose: To provide recognition to the spouse of a member of the EANGUS Auxiliary.
 2. Eligibility: Any spouse of a member of the EANGUS Auxiliary.
 3. Criteria: This will serve as a guideline in selection of recipient.
 - A. Exceptional support of their spouse in their service to the EANGUS. Additional consideration will be given to involvement in civic affairs, community involvement, and professional activities.
 4. Nomination Requirement:
 - A. Letter of recommendation from any EANGUS Auxiliary member with supporting justification to include clear, detailed statements and documentation if appropriate.
 - B. Packet deadline is July 15 of current year.
- C. Recommendations by Awards Chair presented at the first Executive Board meeting at the conference.
