

**Federal Circuit Bar Association (FCBA)  
12th Annual Bench & Bar Conference  
Sponsorship Benefits**

FCBA offers two types of sponsorship opportunities to allow full participation by our member firms at our annual Bench and Bar conference.

**Session Sponsorship:** If you choose to sponsor a conference session such as one of the evening sessions, a refreshment break, lunch or breakfast, you will be recognized in the following ways:

- Recognition on sponsor signage throughout the meeting.
- Recognition on signage during the session.
- Recognition in printed Conference materials.
- One three-month introductory membership for every \$1,000 in session sponsorship support.
- For every \$5,000 in session sponsorship support, one person from the firm may attend the Presidents Reception. This is an invitation only event.

**Please note:** On all session sponsorships, FCBA will seek input from the sponsors regarding the session, but final decision-making will be handled by FCBA.

**Registration Sponsorship:** This type of sponsorship allows firms to send a set number of employees to the Bench and Bar conference, while contributing to the scholarship program under the Federal Circuit Bar Charitable and Educational Fund. There are two levels of this sponsorship available and the benefits are the same for both levels:

- \$8,000 to send two attendees; and
- \$14,000 to send four attendees.

- Three nights lodging at the conference resort. Check-in will be Wednesday, June 23, 2010 with checkout on Saturday, June 26, 2010. Additional nights are the responsibility of the conference attendee.
